

Declaration of Phytosanitary Exemption for MannaPack Rice® Product

This letter serves as a formal declaration of FMSC's Phytosanitary status for MannaPack Rice[®] product. The official letter of Phytosanitary status is issued by United States of American's Minnesota Department of Agriculture for 2024-2025. Minnesota Department of Agriculture has declared MannaPack Rice as "Phytosanitary Exempt."

This exemption has been determined because FMSC raw rice product undergoes further processing, which includes milling and food-safe chemical fumigation specifically designed to eliminate organic foreign materials, pests, and other potential natural vectors that could pose a risk to food safety. These processes ensure that the MannaPack[®] Rice does not pose a threat to public health and is unlikely to harbor any invasive pest species at the time of export.
